#### Calling All Volunteers!

Great news, we finally have permission to expand the number of volunteers allowed in the basement, so if you would like to join one of the teams, please email Lillian Arzaghi, our Volunteer Coordinator, at **fol@lubbockfol.org** and we will add you to a team.

Our number one priority is the safety of our volunteers, so we have a great many protocols in place to make sure you are as protected as possible. These safety guidelines include: teams of volunteers with specific days and times (to minimize exposure in the case that someone does test positive), daily temperature and wellness checks, and mandatory masks and sanitizing. We are also doing some creative thinking to come up with outside-the-box ideas for sales in order to minimize our risk and keep us all safe and healthy.

As soon as the city and library allowed it, we had a limited number of volunteers working hard to sell online, process donations, and renovate the basement to allow for a year-round book store until it is once again safe to have large sales. These intrepid and fantastically hard-working volunteers have truly done amazing things and completed an unbelievable workload. Thank you to all who have been able and willing to volunteer!

One of the projects that has taken place since quarantine includes FOL's effort to separate our newest book donations to supplement the Lubbock Libraries' shelves. All 2018 and newer books were set aside for librarian Beth Carlberg, Lubbock Library's Acquisitions and Special Projects Manager, to process to see which books could be added to the library resources since their book budget was drastically cut. This effort has been tremendously successful, and thus far they have been able to add the following to their inventory:

- 38 bestsellers, 12 this week
- 6 brand new bestsellers that they did not own
- 1 former bestseller they did not own
- 6 copies of a book they have more than 3 holds on
- 14 additional copies of books with very high circulation
- 3 award-winning titles they did not own
- 2 books they borrowed via Interlibrary Loan for users
- 10 books that were circulating very well on Libby, 3 this week
- 22 highly recommended titles they did not own, 10 this week
- 57 mass market paperbacks by popular authors
- 66 popular juvenile novels, 1 added this week
- 4 books that look interesting or have good reviews, 1 this week
- 3 books to replace lost/worn out items, 2 this week
- 5 DVDs, 2 added this week
- 4 large print books
- 2 easy books
- 4 Young Adult books

Since most books retail for \$28-\$30 each, you can see what an incredible impact this has had!

I know a great many people are sad to see no big sales this spring and fall, but FOL is committed to helping our libraries in any way possible. We are off to a great start with our ongoing online sales, back porch sale, personal shopping program, and book store concept. We also encourage everyone to renew their membership in order to participate in these wonderful opportunities, as well as to support our libraries. Thanks again for all of your past support, and we look forward to seeing you all soon!


Volunteers will come to your vehicle, provide a menu to order, take your order, procure grab bags, deliver bags to your vehicle, and collect payment.

**Note:** To participate in the program, **you must be willing to use a** cellphone and email address and be a current member of FOL.

As of October 19th, you can order through email from all sections of Friends of the Library. Regular books are priced at the standard prices of \$0.50 for adult paperbacks and \$1.00 for hardbacks, \$0.25 for children's paperbacks and \$0.50 for hardbacks. Better Books are priced as marked.

Once your order is placed, your personal shopper will work to locate as many of your items as we have on our shelves. When your order is ready, you will be contacted to pick up curbside at the north door of the Mahon Library (1306 9th St.) Monday through Friday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
